Business models

OWIS is sold on a per seat basis. There are essentially two business models:

- On premise – perpetual licenses, hosted within the customer infrastructure
- On demand – cloud based with a ‘pay as you go’ model

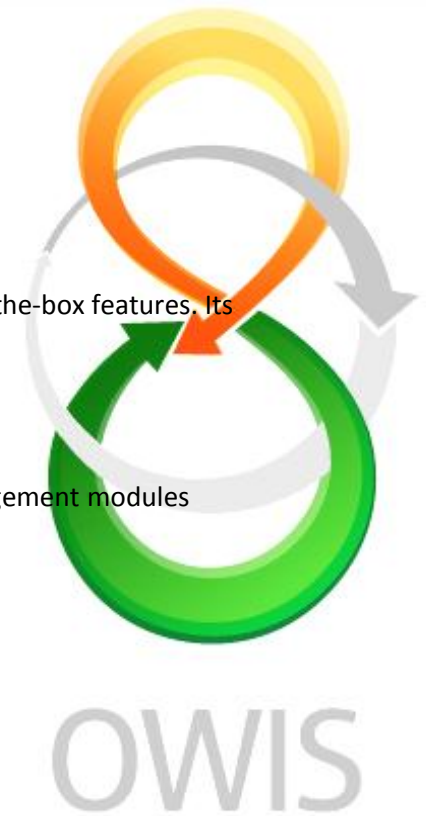
Case studies:

Large organizations, large number of users and documents

Example 0 – 200+ users in a holding of companies, with more than half a million documents. Company employs over 3000 workers in fields of manufacturing and services, and has implemented 5 different backoffice processes through OWIS.

SMB examples

Example 1 – Cloud based solution for trucking business in St. Louis, Missouri, implementation of paperless office. The system caters the needs of a 3 million USD



transportation company with processes such as: Sales, Accounts payable, Repair orders and Leave requests.

Example 2 – Sales process support for an oil distributing company with multiple offices in Netherlands and Bosnia and Herzegovina. OWIS provided a seamless integration of the geographically separated departments in a single company oriented workspace

Banking sector

Example 3 – Bank in Bosnia with 100+ users and implementation of over 20 intra-company processes. System provided horizontal and vertical integration of 16 branches and headquarters.

Government

Example 4 – Government institution with more than 450 users functioning in 17 different organizational units. The system was implemented in the course of two months.

Example 5 – City administration in Bosnia and Herzegovina with more than 30 users and complex processes on a daily basis. The processes include communication and project management with external institutions that are not under city administrations' direction..

Example 6 – Legislative institution in Bosnia; OWIS is used to support complex processes of legislation. Processes were mapped out in OWIS and the system provided unified content repository including documents and information about each and every step of the process.
